

Frequent asked Questions



Do I need previous experience?

No. Whether you have danced before or a complete beginner, you will be put into classes that are aimed for everyone's ability and full training will be given.

How do I join 1st Academy of Dance?

It's simple. Click on our website to fill out our registration form which will automatically be sent to the office. However, if you prefer to speak to someone, please don't hesitate to call on 07880 558031.

Is there a Uniform?

Yes, there is uniform for all our dance classes. Once your child is enrolled, you will receive all uniform information and links to purchase.

Do I need the Uniform before I start?

NO. We don't expect you to rush out and purchase all the necessary uniform in the first week. Therefore a P.E. Kit, tracksuit or any type of leotard and tights are acceptable. We do however ask that the required Uniform is bought within 4 weeks of enrolment.

How do I know which is the correct class?

Once you have decided on which genre your child would like to take part in, we will offer you a paid trial period of 2-4 week, then our teaching staff, will determine which class your child is best suited to, by their age, ability, and previous experience.

Can I enter the I.S.T.D exams?

Yes. All students will have the chance to enter the I.S.T.D exams. When they are entered, will be at the discretion of the teaching team.

How do I pay my Fees?

Fees are paid via Direct Debit and are worked on a Pro Rata basis of 12 equal monthly payments.

As a parent, can I spectate my child class?

Unfortunately, we do not allow parents to spectate their child's regular classes. However, specific Parents days will be scheduled for you to come along and see how your child is developing in their class.

Do I need to give notice if my child is leaving 1st Academy of Dance?

Yes. you need to give 4 weeks' notice in writing. Failure to do so, will result in a further month's payment being required.
